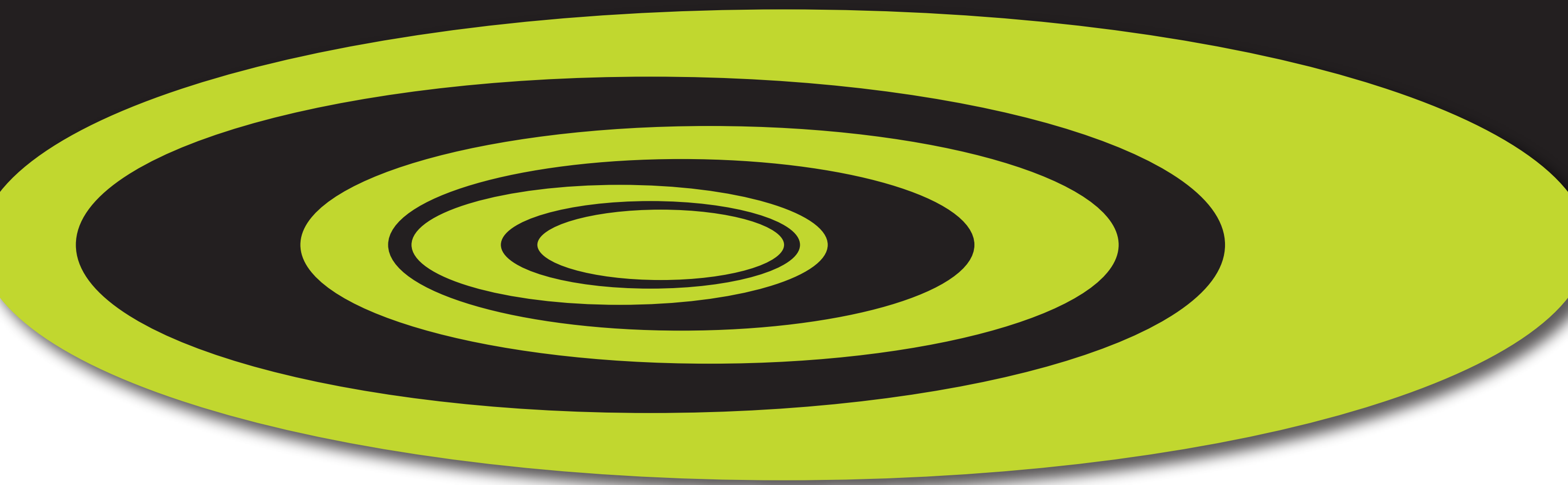


CERTIFIED SECURITIES COMPLIANCE PROFESSIONAL® (CSCP®)



CHECKLIST

ASSESS YOUR CANDIDACY

- Check the Candidate Handbook for exam & credential eligibility criteria to see if you qualify.
- Review the Competency Statements to understand the exam's content.
- Glance through the Curriculum to appreciate the reference material you'll be studying.

REGISTER & SCHEDULE YOUR EXAM APPOINTMENT

- Contact Pearson VUE at www.pearsonvue.com/nscp or call 888-269-2219.
- The fee is \$695 (US and Canada) or \$725 (International) and includes the Curriculum on CD-ROM, writing the exam, the credential application process, and the CSCP Certificate.
- Appointments can be made up to a maximum of six (6) months in advance.

PREPARE FOR THE CSCP EXAM

- Read the CSCP Candidate Handbook in its entirety.
- The CSCP consists of four-option, multiple-choice questions.
- It is a 2 hour, 135 question examination consisting of 100 scored questions and 35 unscored pretest questions.
- Understand that the CSCP is a self-directed study program.
- Use the CSCP Competency Statements in conjunction with the CSCP Curriculum to plan, execute, and customize an exam preparation strategy.
- Visit the CSCP Examination Preparation website for further guidance and assistance.

SIT FOR THE CSCP EXAM

- Arrive 30 minutes prior to your appointment.
- Must present 2 forms of Identification (photo and signature required).

CSCP CREDENTIAL

- Pass the CSCP examination.
- Earn a Bachelor's degree from an accredited US college (or foreign equivalent) and complete three (3) years of securities compliance experience; or complete five (5) years of experience in securities compliance.
- Complete and submit the CSCP Credential Application for approval to NSCP.
- Successful completion of the CSCP program will prompt official notice, via US mail, granting authorization to use the CSCP designation after your name.
- Candidates' names are added to the CSCP Registry. Certification status may be verified by employers, the government, and accrediting agencies.
- Candidates who complete their candidacy will receive a certificate specifying that the CSCP designation has been awarded.

CREDENTIAL MAINTENANCE

- Comply with the required Standards for Maintenance of Continuing Education Units (CEUs) in Certification as established by the Board of Governors and NSCP's Code of Ethics.
